

Membership in AOSCGWA is voluntary and shall be limited to eligible persons who shall be known as Regular Members, Associate Members, and Honorary Members.

Regular Members:

1. Spouses, widows/widowers, and adult family members of commissioned and warrant officers of the U.S. Army who are:
 - a. Active duty
 - b. Reserve Components
 - c. Retired from active duty
 - d. Retired from reserve component duty
 - e. Separated from service who maintain eligibility for rights and privileges that accompany DD- 1173 (family member ID)
2. Commissioned or Warrant Officers of the U.S. Army who are active duty, retired from active duty, reserve components, or retired from reserve component duty.
3. Government Civilian Employees (GS9 and above) or spouses of the same, currently serving or retired.
4. Ex-spouses who maintain eligibility for rights and privileges that accompany DD- 1173 (family member ID).

Associate Members:

1. Spouses, widows/widowers, and adult family members of commissioned and warrant officers of Services other than Army who are:
 - a. Active duty
 - b. Reserve components
 - c. Retired from active duty
 - d. Retired from reserve component duty
 - e. Separated from service who maintain eligibility for rights and privileges that accompany DD-1173 (family member ID).
2. Spouse of accredited Military Attaché and Assistant Attaché assigned to the embassy in Washington, DC
3. Spouse of foreign officer or civilian employee (sponsored by their respective embassy) assigned to duties in the National Capital Region.
4. The President shall invite other persons as deemed appropriate to be Associate Members.

Honorary Members:

1. The President shall invite the spouses of the following distinguished officials and officers to become Honorary Members: President of the United States, Vice President of the United States, Secretary of Defense, Deputy Secretary of Defense, Members of the Army Secretariat (Secretary of the Army, Under Secretary of the Army, Deputy Under Secretary of the Army, Assistant Secretaries of the Army, General Counsel Administrative Assistant), The Auditor General of the Army Staff, Political Advisor-Consultant of the Army Staff, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs, Chief of Naval Operations, Commandant of the Marine Corps, Chief of Staff of the Air Force, Commandant of the Coast Guard, and the Sergeant Major of the Army. The President will offer this status to said person for the duration of their time in the position.
2. The President shall invite other persons as are deemed appropriate to be Honorary Members upon approval of a majority vote of the AOSCGWA Board of Directors present at a scheduled or called meeting.
